

Fuel Surcharge Mechanism Distribution

Fuel is one of our largest costs and as a business we are heavily exposed to changes in fuel prices.

A fuel surcharge mechanism is applied to all rate cards issued and is calculated using the Average Monthly Buying price of fuel. Once the average buying price exceeds 100p per litre, the surcharge mechanism is activated, and the percentage changes are listed in the table below.

This Average Monthly buying price is calculated each month, based on the lower of the average Edge buying price (for that month) or the Monthly Fuel Related Average price published by the RHA.

Changes in the Fuel Surcharge will be communicated each month, at least one week prior to the start of the following month. Changes can go up or down in line with the Average Monthly Buying price.
